Luke 12:51 Do you suppose that I came to grant peace on earth? I tell you, no, but rather division

Matthew 10:34 "Do not think that I came to bring peace on the earth; I did not come to bring peace, but a sword.

- 35 For I came to set a man against his father, and a daughter against her mother, and a daughter in-law bride against her mother-in-law;
- 36 and a man's enemies will be the members of his household.
- **Isaiah 40:9** Get yourself up on a high mountain, O Zion, bearer of good news, lift up your voice mightily, O Jerusalem, bearer of good news; lift it up, do not fear. Say to the cities of Judah, "Here is your God!"
- **Isaiah 52:7** How lovely on the mountains are the feet of him who brings good news, who announces peace and brings good news of happiness, who announces salvation, and says to Zion, "Your God reigns!"

- **Isaiah 59:6** Their works are works of iniquity, and an act of violence is in their hands.

 - **8** They {*i.e.*, human beings} do not know the way of peace, and there is no justice in their tracks; they have made their paths crooked, whoever treads on them does not know peace.
- Mark 7:21-22 For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed the evil thoughts, fornications, thefts, murders, adulteries, deeds of coveting and wickedness, as well as deceit, sensuality, envy, slander, pride and foolishness.
 - 23 All these evil things proceed from within and defile the man."
- Romans 5:1 Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ

22 yet He has now reconciled you in His fleshly body through death, in order to present you before Him holy and blameless and beyond reproach

Romans 6:6 knowing this, that our old self was crucified with Him, in order that our body of sin would be eliminated {i.e., as if the person had never existed}.

Colossians 1:20 and through Him to reconcile all things to Himself, having made peace through the blood of His cross
