- 1 Peter 2:9 You are a chosen race, a royal priesthood
- Exodus 19:6 "...and you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.' These are the words that you shall speak to the sons of Israel."
- Genesis 4:7 If you do well get it, will not your countenance be lifted up? And if you do not do well get it, sin is crouching at the door; and its desire is for you, but you must master it."
 - 12 "When you cultivate the ground, it will no longer yield its strength to you; you will be a vagrant and a wanderer on the earth."
 - 15 So the LORD said to him, "Therefore whoever kills Cain, vengeance will be taken on him sevenfold." And the LORD appointed a sign for Cain, so that no one finding him would slay him.
 - 16 Then Cain went out from the presence of the LORD, and settled in the land of Nod, east of Eden.

When in the Course of human events it becomes necessary for one people to dissolve the political bands which have connected them with another and to assume among the powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which **the Laws of Nature** and of **Nature's God** entitle them, a decent respect to the opinions of mankind requires that they should declare the causes which impel them to the separation.

We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights ...

We, therefore, the Representatives of the united States of America, in General Congress, Assembled, appealing to **the Supreme Judge of the world** for the rectitude of our intentions...

And for the support of this Declaration, with a firm reliance on the protection **of Divine Providence**, we mutually pledge to each other our Lives, our Fortunes, and our sacred Honor

1 Timothy 2:1-2 First of all, then, I urge that entreaties and prayers, petitions and thanksgivings, be made on behalf of all men, for kings and all who are in authority, so that we may lead a tranquil {i.e., free from internal enemies} and quiet life {i.e., free from external enemies} in all godliness and dignity in all well-being, maintaining a favorable culture.
